

Exploring Corporate Development and Industry Frontiers with Didi

On May 21, 2025, a group of faculty and students from School of International Studies CUPL visited Didi. The visit was led by Zhang Wei, Dean of the School, and Wang Fuping, Vice Dean. During the tour, the Didi staff provided detailed explanations, allowing the visitors to gain an in-depth understanding of the company's development history, business layout, and technological innovation achievements. From its initial focus on taxi-hailing services to the expansion into a diverse range of mobility products such as express rides, premium cars, and designated driving services, and further into the exploration of intelligent transportation systems and self-driving technologies.

In the symposium segment, Liu Shaorong, Didi's General Counsel, warmly welcomed the visiting faculty and students from the law school. He then provided a detailed introduction to the company's international operations, focusing on its business development and challenges in Latin America. He encouraged the students to challenge themselves and pursue opportunities overseas. During the Q&A session, the students raised questions on various topics, including legal compliance in the internet mobility industry, passenger safety and privacy, overseas market expansion, market competition, application of artificial intelligence technologies, and internship opportunities. Liu Shaorong responded to each question in detail. The event concluded with a group photo of all participants, marking a successful end to the visit.

"中外文化论坛-英语角"活动



Tai Chi Fan is a fitness activity that combines Tai Chi and fan techniques. Practitioners hold fans and move to the rhythm of Tai Chi, with the fans opening and closing gracefully in smooth, flowing motions like flowing clouds and water. 




The Italian Legal System

Rooted in Roman law, Italy's legal system shaped Western justice, evolving into a modern civil law framework distinct from common law traditions.






Challenge

Rome, the Eternal City, stands as a living museum with iconic landmarks like the Colosseum, Vatican, and Pantheon—where history, faith, and architecture unite.








China-Italy relation

The little red dot has entered the psyche of every Singaporean, and become a permanent part of our vocabulary, for which we are grateful."






Legal system








Food

筷子的使用方法是用拇指、食指和中指夹住 筷子,通过手指的灵活运动来夹取食物。筷子的 种类繁多,常见的有竹筷、木筷、不锈钢筷等。 使用筷子能锻炼手指的灵活性和协调能力,对大 脑发育也有积极影响。此外,筷子还承载着丰富 的文化内涵,是中国饮食文化的重要组成部分。

Chopstick competition

On April 15th, the international students held a unique chopstick competition. After three rounds of intense competition, Sofiia Ivanova and Vladimir Semenov from Russia won the first and second prizes respectively. The students were particularly interested in the competition. Even after it ended, students from Norway and Russia invited a few others to hold another round of competition together.

Chopsticks are a traditional Chinese eating utensil with a history of thousands of years. They first appeared during the Shang and Zhou dynasties, initially used for picking up food, and later became the main dining tool. The way to use chopsticks is to hold them with the thumb, index, and middle fingers, and then pick up food through the flexible movement of the fingers. There are many types of chopsticks, including bamboo, wooden, and stainless steel ones.

参访冬奥场馆 Visit the Winter Olympic venues

5月8日,来自香港的郭浩航同学与同门一起参访了冬奥场馆雪如意。"雪如意"是中国首座符合国际标准的跳台滑雪场馆,位于张家口市崇礼区的古杨树场馆群,是2022年北京冬奥会张家口赛区的重要竞赛场馆。其设计灵感源自中国传统吉祥饰物"如意",外形结构与中国传统吉祥物"如意"的S形曲线完美融合,因此得名。

On May 8th, Kuo Hau Hang, a student from Hong Kong, visited the National Ski Jumping Centre, also known as the "Snow Ruyi," along with his peers. The "Snow Ruyi" is China's first ski jumping venue that meets international standards. Located in the Guyangshu venue cluster in Zhangjiakou City, Hebei Province, it was an important competition venue for the 2022 Beijing Winter Olympics in Zhangjiakou. Its design was inspired by the traditional Chinese auspicious ornament "ruyi," with its S-shaped curve perfectly integrated into the structure, hence the name.
