



Court Visit— A special law class



On 12th April, The defendant Lu gengliang ,who was suspected of the crime intended assault, was on trial in Beijing Haidian district, Shanhou court. In order to let foreign students see how the laws they learn are being practiced and how the procedure works in real life in China. Professor Yue Liling and International communication institute organized 13 foreign students from different countries attended the trial.

The trial lasted for more than one hour, and students benefited greatly from it. After the trial, the students discussed with the judge on the case and asked some questions on Chinese judiciary, such as probation, penalty and victim's forgiveness. "It's really good to experience court and see how the Chinese judicial system works, I hope there will be more chances for us to listen to cases." One of the foreign students said.

庭审实例教学

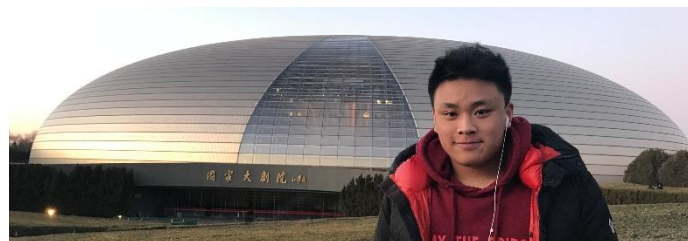

各国继承法论坛

2018年3月28日，在法律汉语的课堂上，来自澳大利亚的大米、德国的马西亚、意大利的猫陶为大家讲解了他们国家的继承法。

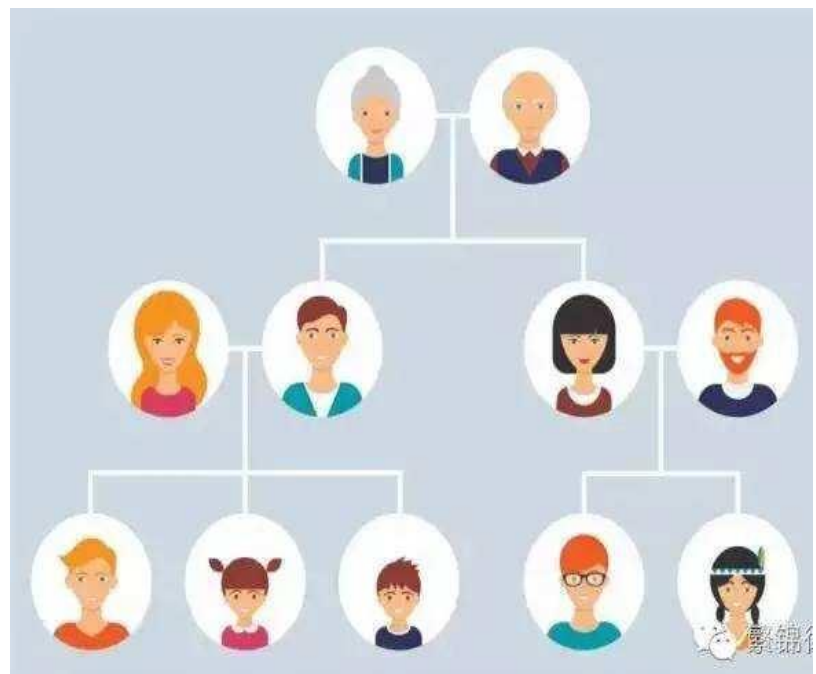
大米同学讲到了澳大利亚2010年新《继承法》，2010年3月1日起，澳州实行新的继承法。根据新的法律条款，若死者没有留下遗嘱，则其配偶（包括现配偶和原配偶）将自动继承死者的房产；死者的子女将不能自动拥有房产继承权，除非他们是死者在先前的婚姻关系中生下的。而此前旧法规定若死者没有留下遗嘱，则其房产须在其配偶（包括现配偶和原配偶）及其所有子女间分配。新继承法将继承权扩大到死者的第一代堂/表兄弟姐妹。新法规定的继承顺位按优先权从高到低如下：配偶及子女；父母；兄弟姐妹；祖父母；阿姨/姑母及叔叔/伯父；第一代堂/表兄弟姐妹。



德国的马西亚介绍了德国继承法中的法定继承顺序，德国继承法在“德国民法典”中指出，如果没有遗嘱，根据婚姻财产制度，配偶有先前的继承权。法定继承人分为下列几类：第一类包括死者的子女（生物和被收养）及其子孙后代。第二类包括死者的父母及其后裔（例如兄弟姐妹或侄子）。第三类包括祖父母及其后代（即牧师的叔叔和表兄弟）等。德国写遗嘱也需要给法定继承人保留特留份。特留份是指法律规定的遗嘱人不得以遗嘱取消的由特定的法定继承人继承的遗产份额。其实质是通过对特定的法定继承人规定一定的应继承份额来限制遗嘱人的遗嘱自由。遗嘱人在设立遗嘱时，如果没有给特留份权利人保留法定的份额，则其相应部分的处分无效。



意大利的猫陶讲解了“意大利民法典”第540条有关继承份额的规定。如果父母去世时只有一个孩子，他/她将被保留一半的遗产。如果剩下两个孩子，这些孩子会分到三分之二的遗产，每人分得相等的份额；如果死者有长辈，他们有权收得三分之一的遗产。如果死者有配偶和一个孩子，他们都有权分得三分之一的遗产。





Special Day for Sweden

Sweden is a Scandinavian country located in Northern Europe and borders Norway to the northwest and Finland to the northeast part. It's connected to Denmark by a bridge-tunnel across the Oresund. The three biggest cities are Stockholm which is the capital, followed by Gothenbourg and last but not least Malmo, his beloved hometown or as the call it in media "Chicago" because of some shootings.

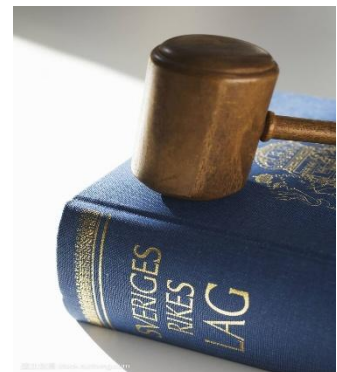

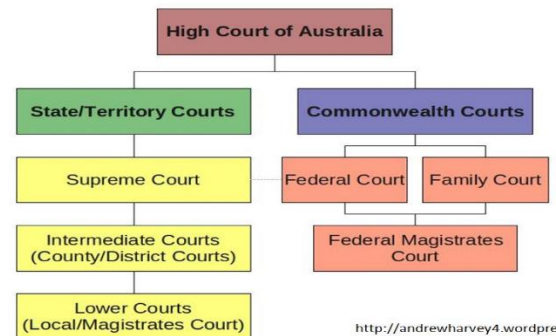
Old coin shows early Chinese contact with Aboriginal people

Australian Court Hierarchy

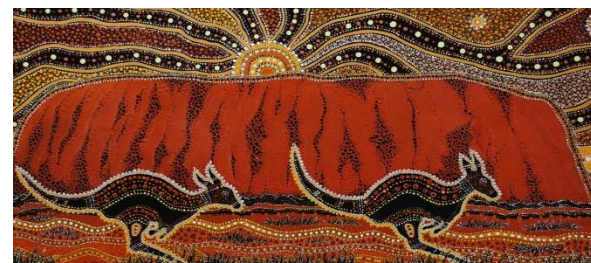

Devina Manka introduced the political system in Netherlands. Since 1815 the Netherlands has been a constitutional monarchy. Since 1848, the Netherlands is also a parliamentary democracy. The Constitution determines how the powers are divided between the monarch and the other institutions of the government. The Constitution is the most important state document and the highest law in the Netherlands. It dates from 1814. The Constitution is subordinate to the Charter for the Kingdom of the Netherlands, which regulates the constitutional relationship between the different states of the Kingdom: Netherlands, Aruba, Curaçao and St. Maarten.



King Willem-Alexander van Oranje-Nassau is the head of state of the Netherlands. He succeeded his mother as monarch on the 30th April 2013. The King is married to Queen Máxima. She is from Argentina. Together they have three daughters: Princess Catharina-Amalia, Princess Alexia and Princess Ariane.

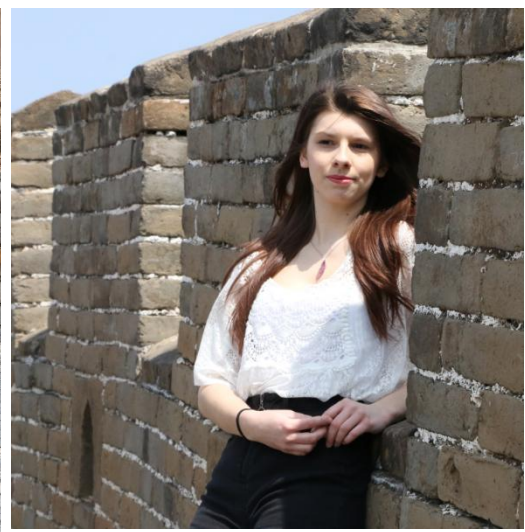
Hi, Zhangjiajie

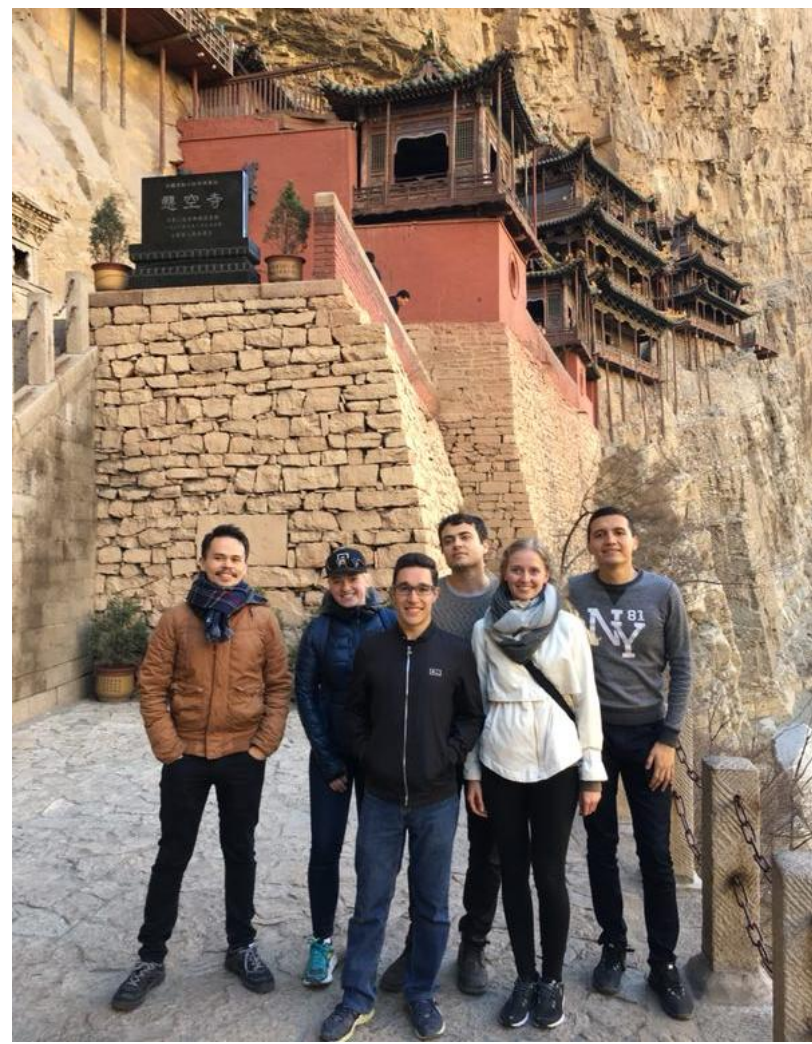


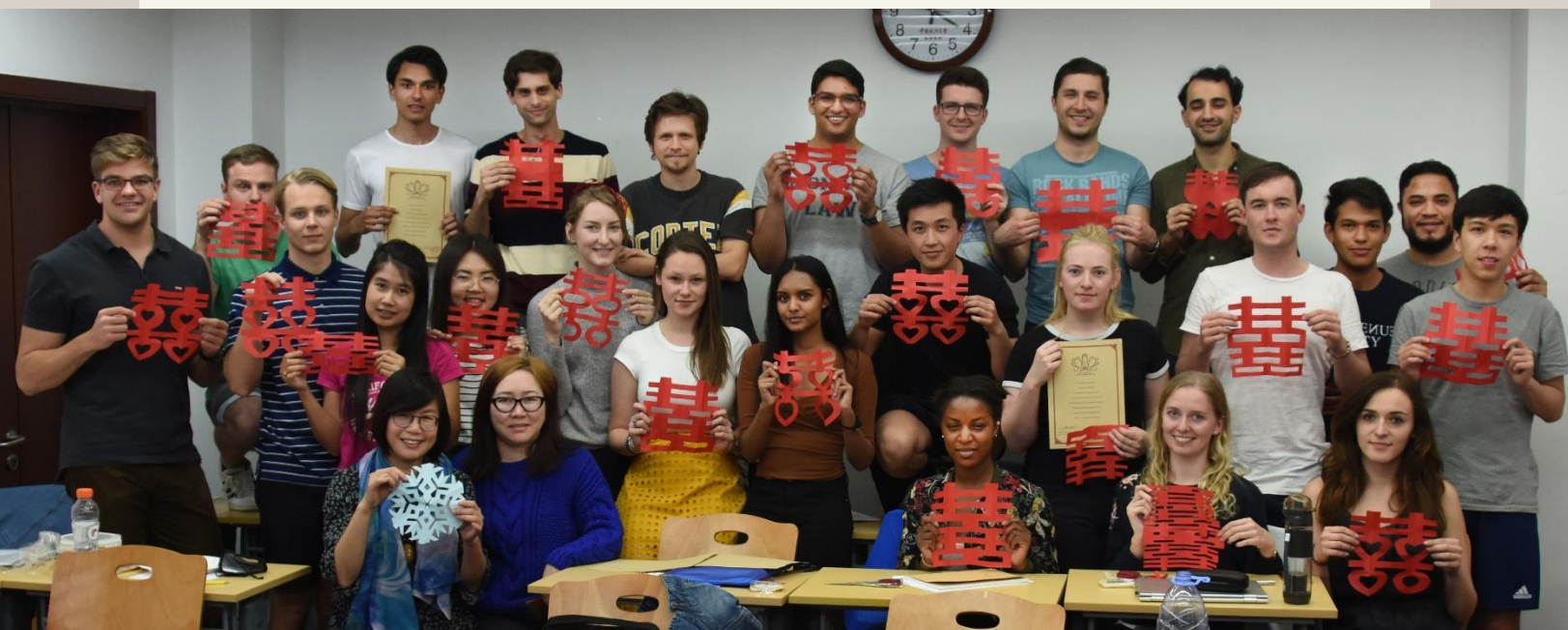

The Hanging Temple is built into a cliff 75 metres above ground, and was built more than 1,500 years ago. This temple is notable not only for being suspended on a cliff, but also because it is the only existing temple with the combination of three Chinese traditional religions: Buddhism, Taoism, and Confucianism.



The other major tourist spot we visited was the Yungang Grottoes. The Yungang Grottoes are ancient Chinese temple grottoes and are an excellent example of rock-cut architecture. They are one of the three most famous ancient Buddhist sculptural sites of China. Besides experiencing some of China's magnificent historical and cultural sites, we also had plenty of time to sit back and enjoy a coffee at Datong.
